


Figure 1. The mechanism model between college students' perception reduction of employment opportunities and their employment pressure




Figure 2. Three aspects embodied in the outlook on life




Figure 4. The smart classroom interaction model




Figure 5. Chinese traditional moral education culture




Figure 6. Hierarchical structure of maturity evaluation of teaching quality management in colleges and universities
